REV. JOHN SHADRACK DONKOH

Rev. Donkoh, a pastor of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Ghana (ELCG), has planted four churches in Ghana, West Africa. Then in 1994 he was called to serve as a missionary to Uganda in East Africa. In the nine years he served there he planted 10 congregations. In 1996, John, with the help of the Lutheran Hour Ministries Area Counselor for Africa and the Middle East, Dr. Menkir Esayas, established a Lutheran Hour Ministry office in Uganda. He became the full time Manager of the LHM in 1999 and through this ministry, planted 7 more churches in Uganda.

John is married to Monica and they have 4 children (Vernon 21, Benjamin 17, Sidney 10 and a daughter Persis 7).

John, who is a regular contributor of devotions on the Lutheran Hour web site, now serves in his native Ghana as the Director of the LHM office in Accra. He is currently waiting for approval to study for his MA at Concordia Theological Seminary in St. Louis, Mo.
