Lutheran Missionary
Lutheran Hour
Ministry Manager
Ghana, West Africa***

John Shadrack Donkoh is a Ghanaian Lutheran Pastor, a product of the Lutheran Seminary in Obot Idim, Akwa Ibome State of Nigeria.

After his seminary training in Nigeria, John was commissioned to serve as an Evangelist to administer Word and Sacrament Ministry. He served for 4 years and planted 4 churches in different new locations of rural Ghana.

In September 1994, John was called by the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Ghana to serve as a pioneer Evangelistic Missionary to Uganda. He served for 9 years in Uganda where he planted 10 churches in 8 different districts of the country and trained several local leaders, most of whom are now pastors serving Lutheran congregations in Uganda.

In 1996, John, with the help of the Lutheran Hour Ministries Area Counselor for Africa and Middle East, Dr. Menkir Esayas, established an LHM office in Uganda. John became the full-time Manager of the LHM in 1999 and through this ministry planted 7 more churches in Uganda.

Rev. Donkoh holds a Bachelor of Mass Communication degree; a Diploma in Journalism; a degree in Divinity and is currently waiting for approval to study for his MA at Concordia Theological Seminary in St. Louis.

John and his wife Monica have 4 children. He loves listening to classical, sacred and choral music. He plays the conga, sings and likes watching football (not American football but soccer). He is a regular contributor of LHM web site devotions and now serves in his native country Ghana as the Director of the LHM office in Accra.

Besides speaking here at Zion this morning, Rev. Donkoh will also be speaking at 7:00 pm this evening at Faith Lutheran Church, 601 North Cliff Avenue.
